Description of the activities that occur at your site:

We have approximately 700 pretrial detainees. Our site provides opportunities for short term therapy, crisis intervention and long term therapy. This department also conducts suicide risk assessments. The mental health department works with the medical department in conducting medication evaluations. There are also ongoing psychoeducational groups in anger management, substance abuse prevention, stress reduction/relaxation, Re-Entry, DBT, interpersonal communication skills, and others. Students are welcome to create new psychoeducational classes as well and co-facilitate any group they would like to participate in.

Description of practicum students' duties at your site:

Practicum students may engage in a number of activities at the jail, including: regular therapy, crisis intervention, intake screening, psychoeducational groups, and there are a limited number of opportunities to conduct assessments.

Type of population with which students would be working (e.g., adults, adolescents, physically challenged, cognitively challenged, etc.):

Students would be working with male and female inmates ranging from age 17-79. This population includes individuals who are physically challenged, cognitively challenged, chronically mentally ill, and a wide variety of behavioral issues.
