Your Site

Description of the activities that occur at your site:

We provide SATOP (DWI) services to individuals in Barry and Lawrence Counties (Cassville and Aurora). With SATOP we provide assessments and teach the 10 hour Offender Education Program (OEP) as well as the Weekend

Intervention Program (WIP). In addition, we are contracted with Missouri's Department of Corrections to provide Intensive Outpatient Services to offenders in Aurora and Buffalo, Missouri. In this work we provide assessments, group education, group therapy, individual counseling, and drug testing. We provide services in Aurora on Monday and Wednesday; Buffalo on Tuesday and Thursday; and Cassville on Fridays.

Description of practicum students' duties at your site:

Students would assist in each of the described settings above. Student would have a chance to work first-hand with clients who have substance abuse problems. Students would have the opportunity to facilitate group education and co-lead group therapy. Client would sit in on individual counseling sessions and assessments.

Adult substance abuse and dependent individuals whom are referred via the legal system of Missouri.
