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### Your Site

Description of the activities that occur at your site:

Initial intakes, individual therapy, some family and couple therapy, group therapy, behavior meetings with a team of providers, report writing (integrating initial intake and assessment), progress notes, and filing

Description of practicum students' duties at your site:

Students will have the opportunity to provide individual therapy to a diverse population including patients with depression, anxiety, adjustment disorders, bipolar disorder with and without psychosis, schizophrenia, dementia, drug and alcohol addictions, personality disorders, and developmentally disabled, most with comorbid chronic medical conditions. Students perform initial intakes, assessments, individual therapy, some family and couple therapy, group therapy, attend weekly behavior meetings with a team of providers (administrators, nursing, social services, psychologist), as well as working alongside physicians. The students will write up initial intakes, administer several screening assessments for depression, dementia, and cognitive decline, anxiety, pain, intellectual impairment, and activities of daily living. They will write progress notes and work with a team of providers on a daily basis. They will also perform some clerical work in each of the facilities and in the office (i.e., filing progress notes, reports).

Type of population with which students would be working (e.g., adults, adolescents, children, physically challenged, cognitively challenged, etc.):

The students will work with adults, ages 20s-90s. Clients have a variety of mental and physical disabilities (see above).
